1 On page 4, after line 35, insert the following:

2 "(8)(a) Prior to imposing a tax under subsection (1)(a)(ii) of
3 this section, a county legislative authority must:

4 (i) Adopt an ordinance prohibiting supervised injection sites
5 within its jurisdiction; and

6 (ii) Adopt an ordinance making it unlawful for any person to camp
7 on public property, without prior authorization from the county,
8 within five hundred feet of: (A) Public or private elementary or
9 secondary schools; (B) public parks, as defined in RCW 69.50.435; and
10 (C) municipal courthouses.

11 (b) Prior to imposing a tax under subsection (1)(b)(i)(B) of this
12 section, a city legislative authority must:

13 (i) Adopt an ordinance prohibiting supervised injection sites
14 within its jurisdiction; and

15 (ii) Adopt an ordinance making it unlawful for any person to camp
16 on public property, without prior authorization from the city, within
17 five hundred feet of: (A) Public or private elementary or secondary
18 schools; (B) public parks, as defined in RCW 69.50.435; and (C)
19 municipal courthouses.

20 (c) For purposes of this subsection (8), the definitions in this
21 subsection (8)(c) apply unless the context clearly requires
22 otherwise.

23 (i) "Camp" or "camping" means to pitch, use, or occupy camp
24 facilities for the purposes of habitation, as evidenced by the use of
25 camp paraphernalia.

26 (ii) "Camp facilities" include, but are not limited to, tents,
27 huts, temporary shelters, or vehicles if said vehicle is being used
28 as temporary living quarters.

29 (iii) "Camp paraphernalia" includes, but is not limited to,
30 tarpaulins, cots, beds, sleeping bags, blankets, mattresses,
31 hammocks, or cooking facilities or equipment.

32 (iv) "Supervised injection site" means any building, structure,
33 site, facility, vehicle, or program including, but not limited to,

1 supervised consumption or supervised injection programs, with a
2 function of providing a space or area for either use or consumption,
3 or both, of federally controlled substances."

EFFECT: Requires a county or city legislative authority to adopt ordinances prohibiting supervised injection sites within its jurisdiction and unauthorized camping within five hundred feet of schools, parks, and courthouses prior to imposing a sales and use tax without an authorizing proposition approved by a majority of persons voting.
