1 On page 21, after line 38 of the striking amendment, insert the  
2 following:

3 "(3) On the last day of January, April, July, and October of each  
4 year, the state treasurer, based upon information provided by the  
5 department, must transfer from the multimodal transportation account  
6 to the general fund a sum equal to the dollar amount that would  
7 otherwise have been deposited into the general fund during the prior  
8 calendar quarter but for the exemption provided in this section.  
9 Information provided by the department to the state treasurer must  
10 be based on the best available data, except that the department may  
11 provide estimates of taxes exempted under this section until such  
12 time as retailers are able to report such exempted amounts on their  
13 tax returns."

15 Renumber the remaining subsections consecutively and correct any  
16 internal references accordingly.

18 On page 24, after line 5 of the striking amendment, insert the  
19 following:

20 "(3) On the last day of January, April, July, and October of  
21 each year, the state treasurer, based upon information provided by  
22 the department, must transfer from the multimodal transportation  
23 account to the general fund a sum equal to the dollar amount that  
24 would otherwise have been deposited into the general fund during the  
25 prior calendar quarter but for the exemption provided in this  
26 section. Information provided by the department to the state  
27 treasurer must be based on the best available data, except that the

1 department may provide estimates of taxes exempted under this  
2 section until such time as retailers are able to report such  
3 exempted amounts on their tax returns."

8 On page 38, after line 21 of the striking amendment, insert the  
9 following:

13 account to the general fund a sum equal to the dollar amount that  
14 would otherwise have been deposited into the general fund during the  
15 prior calendar quarter but for the exemption provided in this  
16 section. Information provided by the department to the state  
17 treasurer must be based on the best available data, except that the  
18 department may provide estimates of taxes exempted under this  
19 section until such time as retailers are able to report such  
20 exempted amounts on their tax returns."

25 On page 39, after line 6 of the striking amendment, insert the  
26 following:

27 "(3) On the last day of January, April, July, and October of  
28 each year, the state treasurer, based upon information provided by  
29 the department, must transfer from the multimodal transportation  
30 account to the general fund a sum equal to the dollar amount that  
31 would otherwise have been deposited into the general fund during the  
32 prior calendar quarter but for the exemption provided in this  
33 section. Information provided by the department to the state  
34 treasurer must be based on the best available data, except that the

1 department may provide estimates of taxes exempted under this  
2 section until such time as retailers are able to report such  
3 exempted amounts on their tax returns."

5       Renumber the remaining subsections consecutively and correct any  
6 internal references accordingly.

EFFECT: Requires the State Treasurer to transfer from the Multimodal Transportation Account to the State General Fund on a quarterly basis the amount that would otherwise have been deposited in the State General Fund if not for the electric vehicle battery and hydrogen fuel cell, infrastructure, and zero emissions bus sales and use tax exemption and the electric vessel sales and use tax exemption.

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
