1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
2 following:

4 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 49.64 RCW  
5 to read as follows:

6 (1) An employer with an established policy, practice, or agreement  
7 to provide vacation leave or other paid time off must provide written  
8 notice to employees of the employer's policy regarding treatment of  
9 unused vested vacation leave or other paid time off at the time of an  
10 employee's termination from employment, including whether unused  
11 vested vacation leave or other paid time off is eligible to be cashed  
12 out.

13 (2) The notice provided pursuant to subsection (1) of this section  
14 must be provided to each employee at or before the time the employee  
15 begins to accrue the vacation leave or other paid time off.

16 (3) The notice provided pursuant to subsection (1) of this section  
17 may be provided electronically.

18 (4) Nothing in this section:

19 (a) Requires an employer to provide vacation leave or other paid  
20 time off to an employee or prohibits an employer from placing limits  
21 on the amount of vacation leave or other paid time off an employee may  
22 accrue;

23 (b) Requires an employer to pay an employee for unused vacation  
24 leave or other paid time off; or

25 (c) May be construed to affect the provisions contained in RCW  
26 49.46.200 through 49.46.820 regarding paid sick leave."

1 Correct the title.

EFFECT: Strikes all provisions of the bill, removing: (1) the requirement that employers pay out vested vacation leave or other paid time off; (2) the inclusion of such leave in the definition of wages under the Wage Payment Act; and (3) the prohibition on required forfeiture of such leave upon termination. Requires employers that provide vacation leave or other paid time off to provide notice to employees of the employer's policy regarding treatment of unused vested vacation leave or other paid time off.
