15 thereby eliminating the federal expenditure ratio requirement for
16 districts to expend three times the statewide average per pupil to
17 qualify for state safety net awards. A state expenditure ratio
18 requirement may be identified in the omnibus operating
19 appropriations act but, if identified, it must be less than the
20 federal expenditure ratio requirement"

EFFECT:

Increases the special education multiplier from a tiered multiplier of 1.00 and 0.9823 in the striking amendment to 1.07.

Removes the 13.5 percent funded enrollment percent limit for special education excess cost funding.

Removes federal funding from the special education safety net.

States that school district cost differences due to best practical efforts to support Individualized Education Plans or to meet goals of including students in the least restrictive environment are a legitimate basis for awards and consistent with legislative intent.

Changes the requirement that districts convincingly demonstrate that expenditures exceed funding from state "basic education" formulas to state "special education" formulas.

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
