- 19 **"Sec. 6.** RCW 4.22.070 and 1993 c 496 s 1 are each amended to 20 read as follows:
- 21 (1) In all actions involving fault of more than one entity, the 22 trier of fact shall determine the percentage of the total fault 23 which is attributable to every entity which caused the claimant's 24 damages except entities immune from liability to the claimant under 25 Title 51 RCW. The sum of the percentages of the total fault 26 attributed to at-fault entities shall equal one hundred percent. The 27 entities whose fault shall be determined include the claimant or 28 person suffering personal injury or incurring property damage, 29 defendants, third-party defendants, entities released bv 30 claimant, entities with any other individual defense against the 31 claimant, and entities immune from liability to the claimant, but 32 shall not include those entities immune from liability to the 33 claimant under Title 51 RCW. Judgment shall be entered against each 34 defendant except those who have been released by the claimant or are

- 1 immune from liability to the claimant or have prevailed on any other
- 2 individual defense against the claimant in an amount which

EFFECT: Provides that under a general wrongful death action or a general or special survival action, a defendant's liability for damages recovered on behalf of a decedent's parent or sibling who is not dependent on the decedent for support is several only, and not joint, if: (a) the total percentage of fault attributed to the defendant is less than 50 percent; and (b) the defendant's liability is not based on an intentional act or omission.

Provides that in an action for wrongful injury or death of an adult child where the parent is not dependent on the child for support, a defendant's liability is several only, and not joint, if: (a) the total percentage of fault attributed to the defendant is less than 50 percent; and (b) the defendant's liability is not based on an intentional act or omission.
