- 9 <u>(i) Receiving one of the following types of public assistance:</u>
- 10 (A) Temporary assistance for needy families, aged, blind, or
- 11 <u>disabled assistance benefits, medical care services under RCW</u>
- 12 74.09.035;
- 13 (B) Pregnant women assistance benefits;
- 14 (C) Poverty-related veterans' benefits;
- 15 (D) Food stamps or food stamp benefits transferred
- 16 electronically;
- 17 (E) Refugee resettlement benefits;
- 18 (F) Medicaid; or
- 19 (G) Supplemental security income; or
- 20 (ii) Involuntarily committed to a public mental health facility;
- 21 <u>or</u>
- 22 (iii) Receiving an annual income, after taxes, of one hundred
- 23 <u>twenty-five percent or less of the current federally established</u>
- 24 poverty level."

EFFECT: Exempts indigent taxpayers from the increased levy rate,
as provided in this bill.
