- 18 (b) Four citizens, who may hold elective office, selected by the 19 leader of the minority caucus of the house of representatives;
- 20 (c) Four citizens, who may hold elective office, selected by the 21 leader of the majority caucus of the senate; and
- 22 (d) Four citizens, who may hold elective office, selected by the 23 leader of the minority caucus of the senate.

- 1 committees of the house of representative and the senate by December 2 1, 2021.

- EFFECT: (1) Requires, by September 1, 2021, the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), to review and revise the procedures and non-statutory criteria used to develop the list of comprehensive sexual health education curricula developed by the OSPI as required by law.
- (2) Directs the OSPI to convene a 16-member work group, with members appointed by legislative leaders of the majority and minority caucuses of the House of Representatives and the Senate, to inform and guide the review and revisions.
- (3) Directs OSPI to provide a report to the education committees of the House of Representatives and the Senate by December 1, 2021.
