- 8 The informed consent form must include a statement regarding the

- 11 (2) The director, in consultation with the board, must develop
- 12 training for manicurists regarding the risks associated with
- 13 performing manicure services for diabetics, how to reduce those
- 14 risks, and how to provide reasonable accommodation to clients with
- 15 diabetes if necessary. The training developed under this subsection
- 16 must be included in the required curriculum for manicurists.
- 17 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. This act takes effect January 1, 2020."

<u>EFFECT:</u> Requires an informed consent form for manicuring services. The form must include a statement regarding the risks that may be associated with a diabetic client receiving manicuring services.
