1       On page 1, line 3 of the striking amendment, after "(1)" strike  
2 all material through "services" on line 10 and insert "The director,  
3 in consultation with the department of health, shall develop signs of  
4 appropriate design and dimensions advising consumers of the health  
5 risks that may be present when manicuring services are performed on a  
6 person that is diabetic. All salons that offer manicuring services  
7 must post the sign or signs in a prominent place for ease of viewing  
8 on the premises of the salon"

EFFECT: Makes the following changes to the requirements related to performing manicuring services on a person that is diabetic:

- Removes the requirement that a manicurist ask a client if he or she is diabetic;
- Removes the informed consent form requirement;
- Requires the Department of Licensing, in consultation with the Department of Health, to develop a sign or signs advising consumers of the health risks that may be present when manicuring services are performed on a person that is diabetic; and
- Requires all salons that perform manicuring services to post the sign developed by the Department of Licesing.

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
