- 5 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 70.128 6 RCW to read as follows:
- If the department has any contracts for personal care services with any adult family home represented by an exclusive bargaining representative:
- 10 (1) Effective July 1, 2020, training required under this chapter 11 for adult family homes must be available through an adult family home 12 training network.
- 13 (2) The exclusive bargaining representative shall designate the adult family home training network.
- 15 (3) The parties to the collective bargaining agreement must negotiate a memorandum of understanding to provide for contributions 16 17 to the adult family home training network. Contributions to the adult 18 family home training network must begin no sooner than January 1, 19 2020. Contributions to the adult family home training network for fiscal year 2021 must be limited to no more than the amount 20 appropriated for training in the 2019-2021 collective bargaining 2.1 22 agreement.
- 23 (4) Contributions must be provided to the adult family home 24 training network through a vendor contract executed by the 25 department.
- 26 (5) The adult family home training network shall provide reports 27 as required by the department verifying that providers have complied 28 with all training requirements."

- On page 3, line 25, after "chapter" strike "70.18" and insert "70.128"
- On page 3, beginning on line 29, after "network." strike all material through "act." on line 34

<u>EFFECT:</u> Specifies that an adult family home training network (training network) must be a nonprofit organization, rather than a nonprofit organization, joint partnership, or trust.

Requires parties to the collective bargaining agreement for adult family homes to negotiate a memorandum of understanding for contributions to the adult family home training network. Delays the commencement of contributions to the training network until January 1, 2020 or later. Limits the contributions to the training network for fiscal year 2021 to the amount appropriated for training in the 2019-2021 collective bargaining agreement. Requires that contributions to the training network be provided through a vendor contract with the Department of Social and Health Services. Delays the availability of training through the training network until July 1, 2020.

Removes the specific topics in the report related to the number and topics of trainings provided, the number of people who completed trainings, and the ability of the training network to provide training in specialty services.

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
