

**SB 5881** - H COMM AMD

**ADOPTED AS AMENDED 04/15/2019**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
2 following:

3 **"Sec. 1.** RCW 46.37.435 and 1990 c 95 s 2 are each amended to  
4 read as follows:

5 ~~((From June 7, 1990,))~~ (1) A person ((who)) is guilty of unlawful  
6 installation of safety glazing or film sunscreening material if he or  
7 she knowingly installs safety glazing or film sunscreening material  
8 in violation of RCW 46.37.430 ~~((is guilty of))~~. Unlawful installation  
9 of safety glazing or film sunscreening material((s. Unlawful  
10 installation)) is a misdemeanor.

11 (2) A person is guilty of unlawful purchase or sale of safety  
12 glazing or film sunscreening material installation services if he or  
13 she provides or receives compensation with the knowledge that such  
14 compensation is for the purpose of installing safety glazing or film  
15 sunscreening material in violation of RCW 46.37.430. Unlawful  
16 purchase or sale of safety glazing or film sunscreening material  
17 installation services is a gross misdemeanor."

18 Correct the title.

EFFECT: (1) Restores the crime of unlawful installation of safety glazing or film sunscreening material, except adds the element of knowledge to the offense. Removes provisions from the underlying bill requiring fixed fines for violations. Replaces references to "materials" with "material" to provide consistency throughout the section.

(2) Creates the separate offense of unlawful purchase or sale of safety glazing or film sunscreening material installation services, which is committed when a person provides or receives compensation with the knowledge that such compensation is for the purpose of installing safety glazing or film sunscreening material in violation of the standard in chapter 46.37 RCW. Specifies that the crime is a gross misdemeanor.
