- 25 (1) The department must provide persons working as early learning 26 providers on the effective date of this section and who are required 27 to have early childhood education initial certificates or short 28 certificates, or both, the option to meet these requirements through 29 their experience-based demonstrated competence.

- 1 (2) An existing early learning provider is eligible to demonstrate their competence if the provider:
- 3 (a) Has been employed by a licensed child care center or home, or 4 both, for a total of seven years by August 1, 2024; and
- 5 (b) Completed all training that was required during the seven 6 years including in-service requirements and health and safety 7 training.
- 8 (3) The experience-based demonstrated competence is an individual determination and is portable between facilities.
- 10 (4) The department must review applications for the experience-11 based competency demonstration and inform applicants of their results 12 on a quarterly basis.
- 13 (5) This section expires December 31, 2025.

 - EFFECT: (1) Changes the date by which a provider must have been employed by a licensed child care center or home, or both, for a total of seven years from August 1, 2024, to August 1, 2026. This change is contingent upon passage of Substitute House Bill No. 2556.
 - (2) Adds expiration dates.
