6 "WHEREAS, Current Washington law may not prohibit the sales of  
7 tobacco and vapor products online, which may result in underage  
8 individuals being able to buy these products online;

9 WHEREAS, The prevent all cigarette trafficking (PACT) act of 2009  
10 requires identification checks of online sales of tobacco by the  
11 delivery system, and 21 U.S.C. Sec. 387f prohibits the sale tobacco  
12 products to any person younger than eighteen years old;

13 WHEREAS, Without amendment to 15 U.S.C. Secs. 375 through 378 and  
14 to 21 U.S.C. Sec. 387f(d)(3)(a)(ii), the minimum age for sale and use  
15 of tobacco and vapor products would remain at eighteen years old;"

17 On page 1, line 17, after "sale" insert "and use"

EFFECT: Changes the scope of the joint memorial to cover the use of tobacco and vapor products in addition to the sale of tobacco and vapor products. Makes additional findings regarding federal laws governing the minimum age for purchasing tobacco products online.
