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21 On page 220, line 11, after "this section" insert "multiplied by  
22 1.152"

24 On page 220, beginning on line 12, strike all material through  
25 line 27.

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1 On page 227, beginning on line 11, strike all of subsection (22)  
2 and insert the following:

3 "(22) \$34,323,000 of the general fund-state appropriation for  
4 fiscal year 2020 and \$62,938,000 of the general fund-state  
5 appropriation for fiscal year 2021 are provided as flexible state  
6 funding to school districts for purposes including, but not limited  
7 to, lowering class sizes; hiring additional counselors, nurses, social  
8 workers, psychologists, or other support staff; offering summer or  
9 additional instructional support time for students, with a particular  
10 focus on at-risk children; and replacing or freeing up current local  
11 levy district expenditures, including expenditures on special  
12 education."

15 insert the following:

21 workers, psychologists, or other support staff; offering summer or  
22 additional instructional support time for students, with a particular  
23 focus on at-risk children; and replacing or freeing up current local  
24 levy district expenditures, including expenditures on special  
25 education."

27 On page 231, beginning on line 30, strike all of subsection (10)  
28 and insert the following:

29 "(10) \$257,000 of the general fund-state appropriation for fiscal  
30 year 2020 and \$746,000 of the general fund-state appropriation for  
31 fiscal year 2021 are provided as flexible state funding to school  
32 districts for purposes including, but not limited to, lowering class  
33 sizes; hiring additional counselors, nurses, social workers,

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1 psychologists, or other support staff; offering summer or additional  
2 instructional support time for students, with a particular focus on  
3 at-risk children; and replacing or freeing up current local levy  
4 district expenditures, including expenditures on special education."

20 and insert the following:

22 year 2020 and \$95,000 of the general fund-state appropriation for  
23 fiscal year 2021 are provided as flexible state funding to school  
24 districts for purposes including, but not limited to, lowering class  
25 sizes; hiring additional counselors, nurses, social workers,  
26 psychologists, or other support staff; offering summer or additional  
27 instructional support time for students, with a particular focus on  
28 at-risk children; and replacing or freeing up current local levy  
29 district expenditures, including expenditures on special education."  
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31 On page 240, beginning on line 26, strike all of subsection (4)  
32 and insert the following:

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1        "(4) \$32,000 of the general fund-state appropriation for fiscal  
2 year 2020 and \$60,000 of the general fund-state appropriation for  
3 fiscal year 2021 are provided as flexible state funding to school  
4 districts for purposes including, but not limited to, lowering class  
5 sizes; hiring additional counselors, nurses, social workers,  
6 psychologists, or other support staff; offering summer or additional  
7 instructional support time for students, with a particular focus on  
8 at-risk children; and replacing or freeing up current local levy  
9 district expenditures, including expenditures on special education."

11        On page 248, beginning on line 1, strike all of subsection (7) and  
12 insert the following:

13        "(7) \$215,000 of the general fund-state appropriation for fiscal  
14 year 2020 and \$396,000 of the general fund-state appropriation for  
15 fiscal year 2021 are provided as flexible state funding to school  
16 districts for purposes including, but not limited to, lowering class  
17 sizes; hiring additional counselors, nurses, social workers,  
18 psychologists, or other support staff; offering summer or additional  
19 instructional support time for students, with a particular focus on  
20 at-risk children; and replacing or freeing up current local levy  
21 district expenditures, including expenditures on special education."  
22

23        On page 249, line 25, strike all of subsection (6) and insert the  
24 following:

25        "(6) \$467,000 of the general fund-state appropriation for fiscal  
26 year 2020 and \$849,000 of the general fund-state appropriation for  
27 fiscal year 2021 are provided as flexible state funding to school  
28 districts for purposes including, but not limited to, lowering class  
29 sizes; hiring additional counselors, nurses, social workers,  
30 psychologists, or other support staff; offering summer or additional  
31 instructional support time for students, with a particular focus on  
32 at-risk children; and replacing or freeing up current local levy  
33 district expenditures, including expenditures on special education."  
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2 On page 251, beginning on line 14, strike all of subsection (2)  
3 and insert the following:

4 "(2) \$1,023,000 of the Washington opportunity pathways  
5 account-state appropriation is provided as flexible state funding to  
6 school districts for purposes including, but not limited to, lowering  
7 class sizes; hiring additional counselors, nurses, social workers,  
8 psychologists, or other support staff; offering summer or additional  
9 instructional support time for students, with a particular focus on  
10 at-risk children; and replacing or freeing up current local levy  
11 district expenditures, including expenditures on special education."  
12

13 On page 288, beginning on line 1, strike all of section 706  
14

15 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any  
16 internal references accordingly.  
17

18 On page 310, line 17, after "41.59 RCW." strike all material  
19 through "expenditures." on page 311, line 19 and insert, "The  
20 legislature rejects the tentative agreement that has been reached as a  
21 whole."

EFFECT: Rejects SEBB CBA. Funds K-12 health care benefits at  
same per member per month level as state employees. Redirects  
savings of \$258 million in 19-21 (\$680 million over 4 year  
outlook) to school districts as flexible state funding for  
purposes including, but not limited to:

- Lowering class sizes;
- Hiring additional counselors, nurses, social workers,  
psychologists, or other support staff;
- Offering summer or additional instructional support time for  
students, with a particular focus on at-risk children; and
- Replacing or freeing up current local levy district expenditures,  
including expenditures on special education.
