 ${\tt EFFECT:}$ (1) Requires agencies to distribute written material to employees on behalf of a nonprofit organization informing employees about constitutional, legal, or civil rights at the organization's request.

- (2) Requires the nonprofit organization to pay for or reimburse the agency for mailing and distribution costs.
- (3) Allows an agency to decline to distribute material on behalf of a nonprofit organization on more than four occasions in a calendar year.
