- 3 "Sec. 1. RCW 28B.10.293 and 1977 ex.s. c 18 s 1 are each amended to read as follows:
 - ((Each state public or private)) (1) Institutions of higher education may, in the control and collection of any debt or claim due owing to it, impose reasonable financing and late charges, as well as reasonable costs and expenses incurred in the collection of such debts, if provided for in the note or agreement signed by the debtor.
- 10 (2) Institutions of higher education may not do any of the 11 following for the purposes of debt collection, unless the debts are 12 related to nonpayment of tuition fees, room and board fees, financial 13 aid funds owed, or fees charged to provide an official transcript:
- 14 <u>(a) Refuse to provide an official transcript for a current or</u> 15 former student on the grounds that the student owes a debt;
- 16 <u>(b) Condition the provision of an official transcript on the</u>
 17 payment of the debt, other than a fee charged to provide the official
 18 transcript;
 - (c) Charge a higher fee for obtaining the official transcript, or provide less than favorable treatment of an official transcript request because a student owes a debt; or
- 22 (d) Use transcript issuance as a tool for debt collection.
- 23 (3) Institutions of higher education may not withhold a student's
 24 official transcript, regardless of debt, if the official transcript
 25 is requested by a student or entity for any of the following
 26 purposes:
 - (a) Job applications;
- 28 (b) Transferring to another institution; or
- 29 <u>(c) Applying for financial aid.</u>
- 30 <u>(4) Institutions of higher education may not withhold</u>

- 10 <u>(b) Information on payment of the debt, including who to contact</u>

- 12 <u>(c) Any consequences that will result from the nonpayment of the</u>
 13 debt.
 - (6) For the purposes of this section:

- 15 <u>(a) "Debt" means any money, obligation, claim, or sum, due or</u> 16 owing, or alleged to be due or owing, from a student.
- 17 (b) "Financial aid funds owed" means any financial aid funds owed
 18 to the institution under Title IV, or to the state, due to
 19 miscalculation, withdrawal, misinformation, or other reason, not
 20 including standard repayment of student loans.
- 21 <u>(c) "Institutions of higher education" means the same as in RCW</u> 22 28B.92.030.

- (e) "Tuition fees" means tuition fees as defined in RCW 28B.15.020, services and activities fees as defined in RCW 28B.15.041, technology fees as defined in RCW 28B.15.051, and fees charged for nonstate funded, fee-based, self-supporting degree, certificate, or continuing education courses, or similar charges for
