- 5 (1) Subject to the availability of amounts appropriated for this specific purpose, the commission shall conduct outreach and 6 coordinate with local law enforcement agencies, fire departments, and 7 other first responder service providers for the purpose of expanding 8 9 critical incident stress management programs to law enforcement personnel, firefighters, and other first responders statewide. The 10 11 commission shall conduct an inventory of the current critical 12 incident stress management programs in the state, including an 13 assessment of underserved agencies and regions. The commission shall 14 coordinate with law enforcement agencies, law enforcement 15 organizations, community partners, fire departments, and other first 16 response service organizations to provide greater access to critical 17 incident stress management programs, including peer support group counselors under RCW 5.60.060, and may further assist agencies with 18 19 establishing interagency and regional service agreements to 20 facilitate expansion of these programs.
 - (2) The commission shall submit a preliminary report by July 1, 2021, and submit a final report, including a summary of the inventory and efforts to expand programs, by July 1, 2022, to the governor and the appropriate committees of the legislature.
 - (3) This section expires January 1, 2023."
