Brief Description: Providing funding for the Washington state library-archives building and operations of library and archives facilities.

Sponsors: Representatives Doglio, DeBolt, Dolan, Walsh, Blake, Springer, Tarleton and Pollet; by request of Secretary of State.

Brief Summary of Bill

- Authorizes a Certificate of Participation for up to \$108 million for a new State Library-Archives Building.
- Authorizes the Secretary of State to manage the construction and operation of the building.
- Authorizes the Secretary of State to enter into a land lease for up to 75 years with the Port of Olympia.
- Changes the name of the Heritage Center Account to the Library Operations Account.
- Adds \$2 surcharge to county recordings, to be deposited in the Library-Archives Building Account.
