Synopsis as Enacted

Brief Description: Making supplemental transportation appropriations for the 2019-2021 fiscal biennium.

Sponsors: House Committee on Transportation (originally sponsored by Representatives Fey and Wylie; by request of Office of Financial Management).

House Committee on Transportation

Background:

Washington government operates on a fiscal biennium that begins July 1 of each oddnumbered year. Supplemental budgets are typically enacted in each of the following two years after the adoption of a biennial budget. Appropriations are made in the biennial and supplemental transportation budgets for the operation and capital expenses of the state transportation agencies and programs.

The 2019-21 State Transportation Appropriations Act (Transportation Budget) appropriated a total of \$9.8 billion from a number of transportation accounts.

Summary:

Transportation Budget appropriations for the 2019-21 fiscal biennium are increased by a total of \$538 million. Fund transfers and other supplemental changes to the 2019-21 Transportation Budget are also made.
