Summary of Bill (First Substitute): Enhances .

Adds exemptions for law enforcement and Halloween costume parties.

EFFECT OF CHANGES MADE BY LAW & JUSTICE COMMITTEE (First Substitute):
Exempts body armor sold to law enforcement for costume parties.
