Background: <u>Transporter License Plates.</u> A transporter's license is required to engage in the business of the delivery of vehicles registered in the state by the drive-away or towaway method. The fee for an original transporter's license is \$25 and the fee for a renewal transporter's license is \$15.

Transporter license plates having an appropriate symbol and serial number must be attached to all cars being delivered or evaluated under the transporter's license. The plates may be obtained for a fee of \$2.
