- 1 AN ACT Relating to reducing government imposed obligations
- 2 associated with bulkhead maintenance or repairs; adding a new section
- 3 to chapter 43.21C RCW; and creating a new section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** It is well established in statute that
- 6 bulkheads are a permitted use and an existing use along the
- 7 shorelines. It is in the public interest for these structures to be
- 8 maintained in good repair. This act encourages maintenance of
- 9 structures by removing an uncertain, lengthy, and potentially costly
- 10 process that ultimately cannot prevent what is legally authorized.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 43.21C
- 12 RCW to read as follows:
- 13 (1) The minor repair or maintenance of existing bulkheads or bank
- 14 protection structures is not subject to the requirements of this
- 15 chapter.
- 16 (2) For the purposes of this section, "minor repair or
- 17 maintenance" means any repair or maintenance that does not involve

- 1 excavation or waterward expansion of the existing footprint of an
- 2 existing bulkhead or bank protection structure.
