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- 1 AN ACT Relating to providing a sales and use tax exemption for
- 2 feminine hygiene products; adding a new section to chapter 82.08 RCW;
- 3 adding a new section to chapter 82.12 RCW; and creating new sections.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1**. The legislature intends to authorize a
- 6 permanent sales and use tax exemption for feminine hygiene products
- 7 in order to lessen the tax burden on women and families in
- 8 Washington.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 82.08
- 10 RCW to read as follows:
- 11 (1) The tax levied by RCW 82.08.020 does not apply to the sales
- 12 of feminine hygiene products.
- 13 (2) For the purposes of this section, the term "feminine hygiene
- 14 product" means sanitary napkins, tampons, menstrual cups, or any
- 15 other similar product sold at retail designed specifically to catch
- 16 menstrual flow either internally or externally.
- 17 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 82.12
- 18 RCW to read as follows:

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- 1 (1) The provisions of this chapter do not apply in respect to the 2 use of feminine hygiene products.
- 3 (2) The definition in section 2 of this act applies to this 4 section.
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** The provisions of RCW 82.32.805 and 82.32.808 do not apply to this act.

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
