- 1 AN ACT Relating to addressing the use of unmanned aircraft to
- 2 deliver contraband to certain facilities; amending RCW 9A.76.010,
- 3 9A.76.140, 9A.76.150, and 9A.76.160; and prescribing penalties.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9A.76.010 and 2013 c 43 s 1 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
 - The following definitions are applicable in this chapter unless the context otherwise requires:
- 9 (1) "Contraband" means any article or thing which a person 10 confined in a detention facility or a secure facility under chapter 11 71.09 RCW is prohibited from obtaining or possessing by statute, 12 rule, regulation, or order of a court;
 - (2) "Custody" means restraint pursuant to a lawful arrest or an order of a court, or any period of service on a work crew: PROVIDED, That custody pursuant to chapter 13.34 RCW and RCW 74.13.020 and 74.13.031 and chapter 13.32A RCW shall not be deemed custody for purposes of this chapter;
- 18 (3) "Detention facility" means any place used for the confinement 19 of a person (a) arrested for, charged with or convicted of an 20 offense, or (b) charged with being or adjudicated to be a juvenile 21 offender as defined in RCW 13.40.020 as now existing or hereafter

- amended, or (c) held for extradition or as a material witness, or (d) otherwise confined pursuant to an order of a court, except an order under chapter 13.34 RCW or chapter 13.32A RCW, or (e) in any work release, furlough, or other such facility or program;
- 5 (4) "Uncontrollable circumstances" means an act of nature such as a flood, earthquake, or fire, or a medical condition that requires immediate hospitalization or treatment, or an act of a human being such as an automobile accident or threats of death, forcible sexual attack, or substantial bodily injury in the immediate future for which there is no time for a complaint to the authorities and no time or opportunity to resort to the courts;
- 12 <u>(5) "Unmanned aircraft" means an aircraft that is operated</u>
 13 <u>without the possibility of direct human intervention from within or</u>
 14 <u>on such an aircraft.</u>
- 15 **Sec. 2.** RCW 9A.76.140 and 2013 c 43 s 3 are each amended to read 16 as follows:
- 17 (1) A person is guilty of introducing contraband in the first 18 degree if he or she knowingly:
- 19 <u>(a) Provides any deadly weapon to any person confined in a</u> 20 detention facility or secure facility under chapter 71.09 RCW; or
- 21 (b) Uses an unmanned aircraft to deliver, or attempt to deliver, 22 any deadly weapon to any person confined in a detention facility or 23 secure facility under chapter 71.09 RCW.
- 24 (2) Introducing contraband in the first degree is a class B 25 felony.
- 26 **Sec. 3.** RCW 9A.76.150 and 2013 c 43 s 4 are each amended to read as follows:
- 28 (1) A person is guilty of introducing contraband in the second 29 degree if he or she knowingly and unlawfully:
- 30 <u>(a) Provides contraband to any person confined in a detention</u>
 31 facility or secure facility under chapter 71.09 RCW with the intent
 32 that such contraband be of assistance in an escape or in the
 33 commission of a crime; or
- 34 <u>(b) Uses an unmanned aircraft to deliver, or attempt to deliver,</u>
 35 <u>contraband to any person confined in a detention facility or secure</u>
 36 <u>facility under chapter 71.09 RCW with the intent that such contraband</u>
 37 be of assistance in an escape or in the commission of a crime.

- 1 (2) Introducing contraband in the second degree is a class C 2 felony.
- 3 **Sec. 4.** RCW 9A.76.160 and 2013 c 43 s 5 are each amended to read 4 as follows:

- (1) A person is guilty of introducing contraband in the third degree if he or she knowingly and unlawfully:
- (a) Provides contraband to any person confined in a detention facility or secure facility under chapter 71.09 RCW; or
- 9 <u>(b) Uses an unmanned aircraft to deliver, or attempt to deliver,</u>
 10 <u>contraband to any person confined in a detention facility or secure</u>
 11 facility under chapter 71.09 RCW.
 - (2)(((a))) <u>Subsection (1)(a) of this</u> section does not apply to an attorney representing a client confined in a secure facility under chapter 71.09 RCW for the purposes of bringing discovery or other legal materials to assist the client in the civil commitment process under chapter 71.09 RCW; PROVIDED, That:
- 17 $((\frac{1}{2}))$ (a) The attorney must be present when the materials are being reviewed or handled by the client; and
- 19 $((\frac{(ii)}{(ii)}))$ The attorney must take the materials and any and all copies of the materials when leaving the secure facility.
- 21 (3) Introducing contraband in the third degree is a misdemeanor.
