The legislature finds that persons attempting to escape from actual or threatened domestic violence, sexual assault, trafficking, or stalking frequently establish new addresses in order to prevent their assailants or probable assailants from finding them. purpose of this chapter is to enable state and local agencies to respond to requests for public records without disclosing location of а victim of domestic violence, sexual trafficking, or stalking, to enable interagency cooperation with the secretary of state in providing address confidentiality for victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, trafficking, or stalking, and to enable state and local agencies to accept a program participant's an address designated by the secretary of The legislature further intends to substitute mailing address. provide assistance to program participants who own or desire to own

- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 40.24 RCW to read as follows:

The secretary of state shall enter into an interagency agreement 5 with the office of civil legal aid to develop and make available 6 information, online self-help resources, and other legal aid services 7 to help participants to own property in the state without public 8 disclosure of such ownership. The secretary of state and the state 9 10 and local agencies and nonprofit agencies designated by the secretary of state under RCW 40.24.080 shall publicize the availability of 11 legal resources and assistance under this section to program 12 13 participants and applicants. The secretary of state may not provide direct legal resources and assistance to participants. No fee may be 14 15 charged to the participants for legal assistance under this section. 16 This section creates no individual right to legal assistance or 17 representation in litigation at public expense.
