- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 9A.08 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 A defendant does not suffer from diminished capacity based on the
- 8 discovery of, knowledge about, or potential disclosure of the
- 9 victim's actual or perceived gender, gender identity, gender
- 10 expression, or sexual orientation, including under circumstances in
- 11 which the victim made an unwanted nonforcible romantic or sexual
- 12 advance towards the defendant, or in which the defendant and victim
- 13 dated or had a romantic or sexual relationship.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 9A.16
- 15 RCW to read as follows:
- 16 A person is not justified in using force against another based on
- 17 the discovery of, knowledge about, or potential disclosure of the
- 18 victim's actual or perceived gender, gender identity, gender
- 19 expression, or sexual orientation, including under circumstances in
- 20 which the victim made an unwanted nonforcible romantic or sexual
