1 AN ACT Relating to restrictions on driver's licenses associated  
2 with certain criminal offenses; and amending RCW 46.20.285.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.20.285 and 2005 c 288 s 4 are each amended to  
5 read as follows:

6 The department shall revoke the license of any driver for the  
7 period of one calendar year unless otherwise provided in this  
8 section, upon receiving a record of the driver's conviction of any of  
9 the following offenses, when the conviction has become final:

10 (1) For vehicular homicide the period of revocation shall be two  
11 years. The revocation period shall be tolled during any period of  
12 total confinement for the offense;

13 (2) Vehicular assault. The revocation period shall be tolled  
14 during any period of total confinement for the offense;

15 (3) Driving a motor vehicle while under the influence of  
16 intoxicating liquor or a narcotic drug, or under the influence of any  
17 other drug to a degree which renders the driver incapable of safely  
18 driving a motor vehicle, for the period prescribed in RCW 46.61.5055;

19 (4) Any felony in the commission of which a motor vehicle is  
20 used, if the sentencing court has entered an order requiring  
21 revocation of the driver's license;

1           (5) Failure to stop and give information or render aid as  
2 required under the laws of this state in the event of a motor vehicle  
3 accident resulting in the death or personal injury of another or  
4 resulting in damage to a vehicle that is driven or attended by  
5 another;

6           (6) Perjury or the making of a false affidavit or statement under  
7 oath to the department under Title 46 RCW or under any other law  
8 relating to the ownership or operation of motor vehicles;

9           (7) Reckless driving upon a showing by the department's records  
10 that the conviction is the third such conviction for the driver  
11 within a period of two years.
