HOUSE BILL 2480

State of Washington 66th Legislature 2020 Regular Session

- AN ACT Relating to providing a sales and use tax exemption for diapers and diaper services; adding a new section to chapter 82.08 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 82.12 RCW; and creating new sections.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature recognizes the significant 7 financial burden that families face in providing diapers for their children. Consistent access to clean diapers is a critical public 8 health issue, helping to avoid dermatitis, urinary tract infections, 9 10 and other painful and dangerous medical complications for babies and 11 their families. Insufficient access to diapers disproportionately 12 burdens low-income families and families of color. A lack of access 13 to affordable diapers can result in negative impacts for children and 14 families' health and well-being and an elevated risk for child 15 neglect and abuse. Additionally, the regressive nature of the sales 16 tax places more financial burden on the most vulnerable families and 17 those with the least flexibility in their budgets. The legislature 18 therefore intends to authorize permanent sales and use tax exemptions 19 for the purchase of diapers and diaper services in order to lessen 20 the tax burden on Washington families and improve public health 21 outcomes.

- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 82.08
 RCW to read as follows:
- 3 (1) The tax levied by RCW 82.08.020 does not apply to sales of diapers or diaper services.
 - (2) The following definitions apply to this section:

- 6 (a) "Diaper" means an absorbent garment that is washable or 7 disposable and is designed, manufactured, processed, fabricated, or 8 packaged for use by infants, toddlers, or children who are incapable 9 of or have difficulty controlling their bladder or bowel movements;
- 10 (b) "Diaper service" means a business that supplies and launders 11 diapers.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 82.12 13 RCW to read as follows:
- 14 (1) The provisions of this chapter do not apply with respect to 15 the use of diapers or diaper services.
- 16 (2) The definitions in section 2 of this act apply to this 17 section.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. This act is exempt from the provisions of RCW 82.32.805 and 82.32.808. However, the tax preferences contained in sections 2 and 3, chapter . . ., Laws of 2020 (sections 2 and 3 of this act) must be included in the exemption report required under RCW 43.06.400 published by the department of revenue.
