1 AN ACT Relating to the retirement age for state guard members; 2 and amending RCW 38.16.015.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 38.16.015 and 2012 c 12 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

(1) The period of enlistment in the Washington state guard shall
be set by regulation by the adjutant general. ((However, no original
enlistment may be consummated unless the term thereof can be
completed before the applicant attains the age of sixty-four.))

10 (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section and RCW 11 38.12.180(2), the adjutant general may extend the service age upon 12 request by an active member of the Washington state guard if the adjutant general determines the member's extension would be in the 13 best interest of the Washington state guard. Extensions under this 14 15 subsection have a one-year duration and may be renewed ((until the 16 member attains the age of sixty-eight)) beyond the age of sixty-four, subject to the discretion of the adjutant general, if: 17

18 (a) The member is physically and mentally capable to complete all 19 assigned mission tasks; and

- 1 (b) The Washington state guard officer review board recommends
- 2 <u>the extension</u>.
