1 AN ACT Relating to Federal Way school district regionalization;
2 and amending 2019 c 415 s 505 (uncodified).

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** 2019 c 415 s 505 (uncodified) is amended to read as
5 follows:

6 **FOR THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION—BASIC EDUCATION EMPLOYEE**
7 **COMPENSATION**

8 (1) The following calculations determine the salaries used in the
9 state allocations for certificated instructional, certificated
10 administrative, and classified staff units as provided in RCW
11 28A.150.260, and under section 504 of this act: For the 2019-20
12 school year and the 2020-21 school year salary allocations for
13 certificated instructional staff, certificated administrative staff,
14 and classified staff units are determined for each school district by
15 multiplying the statewide minimum salary allocation for each staff
16 type by the school district's regionalization factor shown in LEAP
17 Document 3.

Certificated Administrative	\$98,741	\$100,815
Classified	\$47,720	\$48,722

7 (2) For the purposes of this section, "LEAP Document 3" means the
8 school district regionalization factors for certificated
9 instructional, certificated administrative, and classified staff, as
10 developed by the legislative evaluation and accountability program
11 committee on (~~December 10, 2018~~) January 23, 2020, at 8:24 hours.

12 (3) Incremental fringe benefit factors are applied to salary
13 adjustments at a rate of 23.16 percent for school year 2019-20 and
14 23.16 percent for school year 2020-21 for certificated instructional
15 and certificated administrative staff and 20.83 percent for school
16 year 2019-20 and 20.83 percent for the 2020-21 school year for
17 classified staff.

18 (4) The salary allocations established in this section are for
19 allocation purposes only except as provided in this subsection, and
20 do not entitle an individual staff position to a particular paid
21 salary except as provided in RCW 28A.400.200, as amended by chapter
22 13, Laws of 2017 3rd sp. sess. (fully funding the program of basic
23 education).
