1 AN ACT Relating to establishing a Travis alert outreach
2 demonstration campaign; creating a new section; and providing an
3 expiration date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** (1) A Travis alert outreach demonstration
6 campaign is created. By December 1, 2020, the Washington state
7 military department, in coordination with local jurisdictions, shall
8 initiate a demonstration campaign to increase awareness of the
9 benefits and availability of making medical or disability information
10 available to first responders in advance of an emergency. As part of
11 the demonstration campaign, the Washington state military department
12 shall provide appropriate outreach materials to two jurisdictions,
13 one east of the crest of the Cascade mountains and one west of the
14 crest of the Cascade mountains, capable of providing first responders
15 with medical or disability information previously submitted.
