1 WHEREAS, The month of March is Women's History Month and
2 celebrates the significant contributions women of all races,
3 ethnicities, and backgrounds have made to the world; and

4 WHEREAS, The National Foundation for Women Legislators has
5 proclaimed March 19th to be Women in Public Office Day; and

6 WHEREAS, Women play a critical role in the vitality and diversity
7 of our communities, and are essential to ensuring Washington is well-
8 represented; and

9 WHEREAS, While the twentieth century was a pivotal time of growth
10 for women entering politics, women remain underrepresented in male-
