1 WHEREAS, The year 2019 marks the 107th anniversary of Girl Scouts  
2 of the USA, the largest and most successful leadership program for  
3 girls in the world; and

4 WHEREAS, Girl Scouts unleashes the G.I.R.L. (Go-getter,  
5 Innovator, Risk-taker, Leader)<sup>™</sup> in every girl, preparing her for a  
6 lifetime of leadership; and

7 WHEREAS, Girl Scouts combines time-tested, research-backed  
8 methods with exciting, modern programming that speaks to today's  
9 girls and is designed to cater to the strengths of girls' leadership  
10 development; and

11 WHEREAS, Girl Scouts offers girls 21st century programming in  
12 science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM), the outdoors,  
13 entrepreneurship, and beyond, helping girls develop invaluable life  
14 skills and to take the lead early and often; and

15 WHEREAS, As the world's premier leadership development  
16 organization for girls, Girl Scouts welcomes girls of all backgrounds  
17 and interests who want to develop the courage, confidence, and  
18 character to make the world a better place; and

19 WHEREAS, Research shows that girls learn best in an all-girl,  
20 girl-led environment in which their specific needs are addressed and  
21 met; and

22 WHEREAS, The Girl Scout Gold Award, the highest and most  
23 prestigious award in Girl Scouting, calls on Girl Scouts in grades 9

1 through 12 to take on projects that have a measurable and sustainable  
2 impact on a community by first assessing a need, designing a  
3 solution, completing a project, and inspiring others to sustain it;

5 WHEREAS, With more than 100 years of experience, Girl Scouts  
6 brings a wealth of knowledge to programs that deliver to girls  
7 benefits that last a lifetime; and

8 WHEREAS, Today, more than 50 million women are Girl Scout alums,  
9 and 2.6 million girls and adults are current members;

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives  
11 acknowledge and applaud the Girl Scout Movement for providing young  
12 girls with a safe, inclusive space where they can hone their skills  
13 and develop leadership abilities.
