- 1 AN ACT Relating to embezzlement; amending RCW 9A.56.030,
- 2 9A.56.040, 9A.56.050, 9.94A.540, and 9A.82.010; reenacting and
- 3 amending RCW 9.94A.515; adding a new section to chapter 9A.56 RCW;
- 4 creating a new section; and prescribing penalties.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that theft, when
- 7 committed by a person who has been entrusted with the property of
- 8 another, is especially heinous and can involve significant sums of
- 9 money. Embezzlement can be devastating to the victims and put
- 10 businesses in financial ruin. The legislature intends to increase
- 11 minimum penalties for those crimes in order to discourage these acts.
- 12 **Sec. 2.** RCW 9A.56.030 and 2017 c 266 s 10 are each amended to
- 13 read as follows:
- 14 (1) Except as provided in RCW 9A.56.400 and section 5 of this
- 15 act, a person is guilty of theft in the first degree if he or she
- 16 commits theft of:
- 17 (a) Property or services which exceed(s) five thousand dollars in
- 18 value other than a firearm as defined in RCW 9.41.010;
- 19 (b) Property of any value, other than a firearm as defined in RCW
- 20 9.41.010 or a motor vehicle, taken from the person of another;

- 1 (c) A search and rescue dog, as defined in RCW 9.91.175, while 2 the search and rescue dog is on duty; or
- 3 (d) Commercial metal property, nonferrous metal property, or 4 private metal property, as those terms are defined in RCW 19.290.010, 5 and the costs of the damage to the owner's property exceed five 6 thousand dollars in value.
  - (2) Theft in the first degree is a class B felony.
- 8 **Sec. 3.** RCW 9A.56.040 and 2017 c 266 s 11 are each amended to 9 read as follows:
- 10 (1) Except as provided in RCW 9A.56.400 and section 5 of this 11 act, a person is guilty of theft in the second degree if he or she 12 commits theft of:
- 13 (a) Property or services which exceed(s) seven hundred fifty 14 dollars in value but does not exceed five thousand dollars in value, 15 other than a firearm as defined in RCW 9.41.010 or a motor vehicle;
  - (b) A public record, writing, or instrument kept, filed, or deposited according to law with or in the keeping of any public office or public servant;
  - (c) Commercial metal property, nonferrous metal property, or private metal property, as those terms are defined in RCW 19.290.010, and the costs of the damage to the owner's property exceed seven hundred fifty dollars but does not exceed five thousand dollars in value; or
- 24 (d) An access device.

- 25 (2) Theft in the second degree is a class C felony.
- 26 **Sec. 4.** RCW 9A.56.050 and 2009 c 431 s 9 are each amended to 27 read as follows:
- (1) Except as provided in section 5 of this act, a person is guilty of theft in the third degree if he or she commits theft of property or services which (a) does not exceed seven hundred fifty dollars in value, or (b) includes ten or more merchandise pallets, or ten or more beverage crates, or a combination of ten or more merchandise pallets and beverage crates.
- 34 (2) Theft in the third degree is a gross misdemeanor.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. A new section is added to chapter 9A.56 RCW to read as follows:

- (2) (a) A person is guilty of theft by color or aid of deception in the second degree if he or she commits theft of property or services that exceed ten thousand dollars in value but does not exceed thirty thousand dollars in value;
- 11 (b) Theft by color or aid of deception in the second degree is a 12 class C felony.
- 13 (3)(a) A person is guilty of theft by color or aid of deception 14 in the third degree if he or she commits theft of property or 15 services that do not exceed ten thousand dollars in value;
- 16 (b) Theft by color or aid of deception in the third degree is a 17 class C felony.

- (c) An offender convicted of the crime of rape in the first degree shall be sentenced to a term of total confinement not less than five years.
  - (d) An offender convicted of the crime of sexually violent predator escape shall be sentenced to a minimum term of total confinement not less than sixty months.
  - (e) An offender convicted of the crime of aggravated first degree murder for a murder that was committed prior to the offender's eighteenth birthday shall be sentenced to a term of total confinement not less than twenty-five years.
  - (f) An offender convicted of the crime of theft by color or aid of deception in the first degree must be sentenced to a minimum term of total confinement not less than five years.
  - (2) During such minimum terms of total confinement, no offender subject to the provisions of this section is eligible for community custody, earned release time, furlough, home detention, partial confinement, work crew, work release, or any other form of early release authorized under RCW 9.94A.728, or any other form of authorized leave of absence from the correctional facility while not in the direct custody of a corrections officer. The provisions of this subsection shall not apply: (a) In the case of an offender in need of emergency medical treatment; (b) for the purpose of
