- AN ACT Relating to modifying the aircraft excise tax; amending 1 2 RCW 82.48.030; reenacting and amending RCW 82.48.010; and providing
- 3 an effective date.

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- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON: 4
- 5 RCW 82.48.010 and 2013 c 56 s 2 are each reenacted and Sec. 1. 6 amended to read as follows:
 - The definitions in this section apply throughout this chapter unless the context clearly requires otherwise.
- (1) "Aircraft" means any weight-carrying device or structure for 9 10 navigation of the air which is designed to be supported by the air.
- (2) "Commercial" means an aircraft, manned or unmanned, not used 11 exclusively for hobby or recreation. 12
 - (3) "Commuter air carrier" means an air carrier holding authority under Title 14, Part 298 of the code of federal regulations that carries passengers on at least five round trips per week on at least one route between two or more points according to its published flight schedules that specify the times, days of the week, and places between which those flights are performed.
- 19 ((3) "Large multi-engine fixed wing" means any piston-driven 20 multi-engine fixed wing aircraft with a maximum gross weight as 21 listed by the manufacturer of seventy-five hundred pounds or more.))

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- 9 (((6) "Small multi-engine fixed wing" means any piston-driven 10 multi-engine fixed wing aircraft with a maximum gross weight as 11 listed by the manufacturer of less than seventy-five hundred 12 pounds.))
- 13 <u>(8) "Small unmanned aircraft" means a small unmanned aircraft or</u> 14 drone, weighing less than fifty-five pounds on takeoff.

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- (2) (a) The amount of tax imposed under subsection (1) of this section for each calendar year must be divided into twelve parts corresponding to the months of the calendar year and the excise tax upon an aircraft registered for the first time in this state after the last day of any month may only be levied for the remaining months of the calendar year including the month in which the aircraft is being registered. However, the minimum amount payable is three dollars.
- 12 (b) An aircraft is deemed registered for the first time in this 13 state when such aircraft was not previously registered by this state 14 for the year immediately preceding the year in which application for 15 registration is made.
- 16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act takes effect January 1, 2020.

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
