- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 36.70A.400 and 1993 c 478 s 11 are each amended to read as follows:
 - (1) For the purposes of this section:
- 7 (a) "Tiny house" means a dwelling to be used as permanent housing
 8 with permanent provisions for living, sleeping, eating, cooking, and
 9 sanitation built in accordance with the 2018 International Resident
 10 Code Appendix Q.
- 11 <u>(b) "Tiny house with wheels" means a dwelling to be used as</u>
 12 permanent housing with permanent provisions for living, sleeping,
 13 eating, cooking, and sanitation built by a manufacturer that is self-
- 14 <u>certified under RCW 43.22.355.</u>
- 15 <u>(2)</u> Any local government, as defined in RCW 43.63A.215, that is planning under this chapter shall comply with RCW 43.63A.215(3).
- 17 (3) A tiny house may be allowed as an accessory dwelling unit 18 within designated urban growth areas for the purposes of permanent
- 19 <u>residence without being attached to or constructed within the primary</u>
- 20 <u>dwelling unit.</u>
