- AN ACT Relating to reducing a tax preference for prescription drug warehousing to invest in opioid abuse treatment services in rural and high-need areas; adding a new section to chapter 82.32 RCW; repealing RCW 82.04.272; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. RCW 82.04.272 (Tax on warehousing and reselling prescription drugs) and 2013 c 19 s 127, 2003 c 168 s 401, 8 1998 c 343 s 1 are each repealed.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 82.32
 RCW to read as follows:
- By January 1, 2020, and by January 1st of each year thereafter, 12 the department must estimate the increase to the general fund due to 13 14 the elimination of the tax preference in RCW 82.04.272 for the 15 current biennium and two subsequent biennia. The department must 16 notify the appropriate legislative fiscal committees of the amount 17 determined by the department under this section. The state omnibus appropriations act must separately appropriate the amount determined 18 19 under this section specifically for opioid abuse treatment services 20 in rural and high need areas.

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NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. This act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect July 1, 2019.

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
