- 7 (1) Each retail outlet must report any attempt or incident of 8 robbery in the first or second degree at the retail outlet to the
- 9 board within ten days of the attempt or incident.
- 10 (2) The board's chief enforcement officer must regularly consult

- 12 incidents of robbery in the first or second degree of a retail outlet
- 13 and to discuss any evidence that indicates a pattern of,
- 14 coordinated effort by, a criminal enterprise.
