1 AN ACT Relating to the safety and security of retail marijuana
2 outlets; amending RCW 9.94A.832; and adding a new section to chapter
3 69.50 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 69.50
6 RCW to read as follows:

7 (1) A law enforcement agency must forward the offense report
8 regarding any incident of robbery in the first or second degree of a
9 retail outlet to the Washington state patrol within ten days of
10 making the report if there is probable cause to believe that an
11 offense has been committed, unless the case is under active
12 investigation.

13 (2) The Washington state patrol must provide details of incidents
14 of robbery in the first or second degree of a retail outlet to the
15 board, within ten days of the state patrol's receipt of a report
16 under subsection (1) of this section.

17 **Sec. 2.** RCW 9.94A.832 and 2013 c 270 s 1 are each amended to
18 read as follows:

19 In a criminal case where(÷

1 ~~(1)~~) the defendant has been convicted of robbery in the first
2 degree or robbery in the second degree(~~(1)~~) and
3 (~~(2)~~) there has been a special allegation pleaded and proven
4 beyond a reasonable doubt that the defendant committed a robbery of:
5 (1) A pharmacy as defined in RCW 18.64.011(~~(21)~~); or
6 (2) A marijuana retail outlet, licensed under chapter 69.50 RCW,
7 and the defendant committed the robbery as a premeditated act in
8 concert with another individual or individuals;
9 the court shall make a finding of fact of the special allegation, or
10 if a jury is had, the jury shall, if it finds the defendant guilty,
11 also find a special verdict as to the special allegation.
