1 AN ACT Relating to creating a retail liquor license for
2 restaurants operated in connection with a course offered by
3 postsecondary institutions; and adding a new section to chapter 66.24
4 RCW.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 66.24
7 RCW to read as follows:

8 (1) There is a retailer's license, designated as a spirits, beer,
9 and wine school-operated restaurant, to sell spirituous liquor by the
10 individual glass, beer, and wine, at retail, for consumption on the
11 premises, including mixed drinks and cocktails compounded or mixed on
12 the premises only. The license issuance and renewal fee is one
13 thousand dollars per year. A license may be issued only to an
14 applicant who is a postsecondary institution as defined in RCW
15 28B.10.016 and who will use the license as part of a course or
16 training program for students of the postsecondary institution.

17 (2) Except as provided in this section, all the privileges and
18 limitations of a spirits, beer, and wine restaurant license issued
19 under RCW 66.24.400 apply to a license issued under this section.

20 (a) The board shall establish food service requirements for a
21 license issued under this section. The food service requirements may

1 include requirements to serve complete meals when open to the public,
2 but may not require a licensee to serve as many complete meals as the
3 board requires of spirits, beer, and wine restaurants licensed under
4 RCW 66.24.400.

5 (b) A licensee operating under this section may operate under
6 hours established by the licensee.

7 (3) The same alcohol server training requirements applicable to
8 workers at spirits, beer, and wine restaurants licensed under RCW
9 66.24.400 apply to workers, students, and any person who engages in
10 the sale or service of liquor authorized under this section.
