  AND ROBERT LIGHTHIZER, UNITED STATES TRADE REPRESENTATIVE:
- We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully represent and petition as follows:
- 6 WHEREAS, The United States and China are involved in ongoing 7 trade discussions; and
- 8 WHEREAS, China is one of the world's largest sources of plastic 9 pollution, much of which ends up in the ocean; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The Yangtze river in China is to blame for more marine 11 plastic pollution than any other river in the world; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Marine plastic pollution is a threat to the environment, 13 including fish and wildlife; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The most effective way to stop marine plastic pollution 15 is to focus on the places where the pollution originates;
- NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully ask that you take action pursuant to your authority to require China to prevent marine plastic pollution under any new trade agreement that may arise from your administration's ongoing trade discussions.
