1 AN ACT Relating to an employer's payment of indebtedness; and 2 amending RCW 49.48.120.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 49.48.120 and 2018 c 57 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

6 (1) If at the time of the death of any person, his or her 7 employer is indebted to him or her for work, labor, and services performed, and no executor or administrator of his or her estate has 8 been appointed, the employer shall upon the request of the surviving 9 10 spouse pay the indebtedness in an amount as may be due not exceeding 11 the sum of ((two thousand five hundred)) ten thousand dollars, to the surviving spouse, or if the decedent leaves no surviving spouse, then 12 13 to the decedent's child or children, or if no children, then to the decedent's father or mother. 14

15 (2) In the event the decedent's employer is the state of 16 Washington or a municipal corporation, as defined in RCW 39.50.010, 17 then there shall be no limit to the amount of the indebtedness that 18 can be paid under subsection (1) of this section.

(3) If the decedent and the surviving spouse have entered into a
 community property agreement that meets the requirements of RCW
 26.16.120, and the right to the indebtedness became the sole property

of the surviving spouse upon the death of the decedent, the employer shall pay to the surviving spouse the total of the indebtedness, or that portion which is governed by the community property agreement, upon presentation of the agreement accompanied by an affidavit or declaration of the surviving spouse stating that the agreement was executed in good faith between the parties and had not been rescinded by the parties before the decedent's death.

8 (4) In all cases, the employer shall require proof of the 9 claimant's relationship to the decedent by affidavit or declaration, 10 and shall require the claimant to acknowledge receipt of the payment 11 in writing.

12 (5) Any payments made by an employer pursuant to the provisions 13 of RCW 49.48.115 and this section shall operate as a full and 14 complete discharge of the employer's indebtedness to the extent of 15 the payment, and no employer shall thereafter be liable to the 16 decedent's estate, or the decedent's executor or administrator 17 thereafter appointed.

(6) The employer may also pay the indebtedness upon presentationof an affidavit as provided in RCW 11.62.010.
