1 WHEREAS, It is the policy of the Washington State Legislature to
2 recognize excellence in all fields of endeavor; and

3 WHEREAS, The Kittitas Secondary School boys' basketball team
4 exhibited the highest level of excellence in overcoming the
5 competition and winning the Washington State 2B Championship game on
6 March 2, 2019, by a score of 79 to 51; and

7 WHEREAS, The Coyotes demonstrated spirited play and exemplary
8 leadership in achieving this outstanding accomplishment; and

9 WHEREAS, The team surpassed the Saint George's High School
10 Dragons for the second consecutive time at the annual Washington
11 State 2B Championship tournament, and became the third team to
12 achieve a 2B basketball "three-peat"; and

13 WHEREAS, Guard Brock Ravet was named the 2B tournament's Most
14 Outstanding Player for the third time, and finished his career as a
15 Coyote by becoming the state's first high school player to reach
16 3,000 career points, and assuming the title of the state's all-time
17 scoring leader; and

18 WHEREAS, Head Coach Tim Ravet and all the Coyote players, Caleb
19 Harris, Justin Hudson, Treyden Wilson, Jesus Velazquez, Bailey
20 Gibson, Christian Mata, Cody Van Dorn, Beau Bryant, Blake Catlin,
21 Dawson Byers, Martin Arreola, Brock Ravet, Kolten Udager, and Nick
22 Patteson share in the team's success by combining outstanding
23 coaching with outstanding sportsmanship; and

1 WHEREAS, The inspiring individual and team achievements of the
2 2019 Kittitas Secondary School Coyotes boys' basketball team will
3 always be remembered as a source of great pride by all the citizens
4 of their community and of the state of Washington;

6 honor the 2019 Kittitas Secondary School boys' basketball team; and
