- 1 WHEREAS, Washington State is committed to the promotion of safety 2 programs, policies, and actions; and
- WHEREAS, Thousands of motorcyclists travel the roads, streets, highways, and interstate systems of Washington State every day; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Motorcycles are fuel efficient vehicles that have access 6 to Washington State High Occupancy Vehicle lanes, promoting a less 7 congested travel way; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Motorcyclists help to provide funds for the 9 transportation infrastructure of Washington State that they and 10 others use; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The majority of the motorcycling community is committed 12 to motorcycle safety and awareness and promotes policies and 13 procedures for themselves and other motorists in order to create a 14 safe roadway for all; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Motorcyclists make up just about three percent of all 16 registered vehicles but account for about 14 percent of all traffic 17 fatalities as of 2015; and

  19 National Highway Traffic Safety Administration launched a Get Up to
  20 Speed on Motorcycles campaign to help motorists learn how to drive
  21 safely around motorcycles in order to keep all roadway users safe;
