6 relevant and reliable sources, including, but not limited to, local
7 governments, state agencies, federal agencies, and Indian tribes"

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9 On page 19, line 40, after "time" insert ", including, where
10 appropriate, the efforts made by jurisdictions to address the effect
11 of urban heat islands on salmonid health"

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EFFECT: Requires the Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW),
in the course of its monitoring and reporting obligations under the
bill, to:

- Monitor and report on parameters that affect salmonid health,
including, but not limited to, stream temperatures, impervious
surfaces, and tree canopy cover.
- Obtain, where appropriate, monitoring data from relevant and
reliable sources, including, but not limited to, local
governments, state agencies, federal agencies, and Indian
tribes; and
- Report, where appropriate, on efforts made by local governments
to address the effect of urban heat islands on salmonid health.

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
