EFFECT:

(1) Requires the Foundational Public Health Services Steering Committee (Steering Committee) to identify and develop foundational public health services funding recommendations that promote new service delivery models, which the Public Health Advisory Board (Advisory Board) is authorized to approve.

(2) Modifies the amount of foundational public health services funding that must be reserved for shared services, so that the requirement that the Department of Health (DOH) allocate 65% of funding that exceeds \$30 million per biennium for shared services only applies to fiscal years 2021 through 2023, after which the DOH must allocate funding for shared services as recommended by the Steering Committee and approved by the Advisory Board.

(3) Modifies the null and void clause, so that the null and void is dependent on at least \$60 million being appropriated for foundational public health services, rather than for purposes the sections in the act related to Regional Comprehensive Public Health Services District Centers.

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
