1 On page 1, line 10, after "emissions." insert "The governor's
2 emergency orders restricting activity to prevent the spread of the
3 novel coronavirus (COVID-19) have reduced transportation sector
4 emissions and have also reduced government revenues to pay for new
5 transportation programs."

7 On page 12, after line 15, insert the following:

8 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 5.** (1) This act takes effect 90 days
9 following the later of:

10 (a) The date of expiration or termination of proclamation 20-05
11 and any subsequent orders extending or amending the proclamation,
12 declaring a state of emergency on February 29, 2020, for all counties
13 in Washington due to COVID-19; or

14 (b) The adjournment of the 2021 regular legislative session.

15 (2) The office of the governor must provide written notice of
16 the effective date of this act to affected parties, the chief clerk
17 of the house of representatives, the secretary of the senate, the
18 office of the code reviser, and others as deemed appropriate."

20 Correct the title.

EFFECT: Gives the act an effective date of the later of: (1) 90 days after the expiration or termination of the Governor's proclamation declaring a state of emergency on February 29, 2020, due to the COVID-19 pandemic; or (2) 90 days after the adjournment of the 2021 regular legislative session. Requires the Governor's Office to provide written notice of the effective date to the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives, Secretary of the Senate, Office of the Code Reviser, and affected parties. Adds language to the intent section regarding the effect of the novel coronavirus on transportation sector emissions and revenues.

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
