1 On page 2, after line 19, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 2. RCW 49.17.370 and 2004 c 1 s 2 (Initiative Measure No.
3 841, approved November 4, 2003) are each amended to read as follows:

4 For the purposes of this section, "state ergonomics regulations"
5 are defined as the rules addressing musculoskeletal disorders,
6 adopted on May 26, 2000, by the director of the department of labor
7 and industries, and codified as WAC 296-62-05101 through
8 296-62-05176. The state ergonomics regulations, filed on May 26,
9 2000, by the director and codified as WAC 296-62-05101 through
10 296-62-05176 are repealed. The director shall not have the authority
11 to adopt any new or amended rules dealing with musculoskeletal
12 disorders, or that deal with the same or similar activities as these
13 rules being repealed(~~(, until and to the extent required by congress~~
14 ~~or the federal occupational safety and health administration), until~~
15 the department develops a job displacement and retraining plan in
16 collaboration with the employment security department and state
17 workforce training and education coordinating board for employees
18 whose jobs are replaced by automation."

EFFECT: Removes the bill's repeal of the restriction on
regulating work-related musculoskeletal disorders and ergonomics,
and instead provides that the Department of Labor and Industries may
not adopt similar rules until it develops a job displacement and
retraining plan for employees whose jobs are replaced by automation.
