Said code is 8 ((intended to embrace in a revised)), consolidated, and codified form and arrangement all the laws of the state of a general and permanent 9 10 nature.

12 Sec. 2. RCW 1.04.020 and 1951 c 5 s 6 are each amended to read 13 as follows:

14 The contents of the Revised Code of Washington, after striking 15 therefrom sections repealed or superseded by laws of the state of 16 Washington enacted since January 1, 1949, as the revised code is supplemented or modified in the 1950 supplement, shall establish the 17 laws of this state of a general and permanent nature in effect on 18 19 January 1, 1951; except, that nothing herein shall be construed as 20 changing the meaning of any such laws and, as a rule of construction, 21 in case of any ((omissions or any inconsistency)) between any of the provisions of the revised code as so supplemented or modified and the 22 23 laws existing immediately preceding this enactment, the previously existing laws shall control. Any section of the Revised Code of 24 25 Washington (as supplemented or modified by the 1950 supplement) expressly amended by the legislature, including the entire context 26 27 set out, shall, as so amended, constitute the law and the ultimate declaration of legislative intent. 28
