

**ESSB 5092** - H AMD TO H AMD (H-1459.2/21) **522**

1 On page 5, line 22, increase the general fund-state appropriation  
2 for fiscal year 2022 by \$50,000,000

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4 On page 5, line 23, increase the general fund-state appropriation  
5 for fiscal year 2023 by \$50,000,000

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7 On page 5, line 30, correct the total.

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9 On page 8, after line 32, insert the following:

10 "(11) \$50,000,000 of the general fund-state appropriation for  
11 fiscal year 2022 and \$50,000,000 of the general fund-state  
12 appropriation for fiscal year 2023 are provided solely for the  
13 implementation of House Bill No. 1559 (behavioral health response-  
14 juveniles and controlled substances), House Bill No. 1560 (mens rea  
15 element - possession of substances), House Bill No. 1561 (offenses and  
16 penalties - controlled substances and counterfeit substances), and  
17 House Bill No. 1562 (local laws and ordinances - possession of  
18 controlled substances and counterfeit substances). If none of these  
19 bills is enacted by June 30, 2021, the amounts provided in this  
20 subsection shall lapse."

EFFECT: Provides \$100 million in the 2021-23 biennium to fund local costs associated with the implementation of HB 1559 (behavioral health response- juveniles and controlled substances), HB 1560 (mens rea element - possession of substances), HB 1561 (offenses and penalties - controlled substances and counterfeit substances), and HB 1562 (local laws and ordinances - possession of controlled substances and counterfeit substances).

FISCAL IMPACT:

Increases General Fund - State by \$100,000,000.

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
